



Call for Applications: Albert Einstein German Academic Refugee Initiative (DAFI) for 2021



Applications are open as from **13 November 2020**

Applications closing date: **30 November 2020**

To meet eligibility criteria of the scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a refugee with recognized refugee status currently living in Namibia.
- Age of 28 or younger
- Holding a higher secondary certificate or currently in grade 12
- Excellent academic performance
- You have never received an academic scholarship
- Have no family members receiving DAFI scholarship
- Strong motivation to contribute to your community

If you meet the above qualifications, you are invited to apply for the DAFI scholarship for 2021.

This scholarship programme is funded by the German Government and administered by UNHCR with assistance from SFH, to help refugee students to access higher education. The scholarship covers a wide range of costs: from tuition fees, study materials, monthly stipends, and accommodation. The scholarship is only available for students intending to study at accredited institutions of higher learning in Namibia.
